SOUTHERN UNIVERSITY PROPERTY IS SOLD

Buildings and Lot Bought in at Auction by Harry McEnerny.

The Southern University square bounded by Magazine, Sonlai, Dufossat and Constance streets, offered at the New Orleans Auction Exchange Tuesday by C. A. Tessier & Son, was sold for \$18,000 to Harry McEnerny. The square is surrounded by magnificent oak trees. The handsome college buildings are of brick. The school was built by the State of Louisiana for the oducation of negro youths, but was abonded when the university was removed to Baton Rouge last year. The farm belonging to the school was at Avondale, just above the city, and was sold for a townsite at Harchan. The purchaser was unwilling to make public at present the purpose of the purchase of the square, but it was learned that the jurchase was on account of interests which are likely to invest considerable money in properly in Now Orleans.

Ramsey & Danzior sold a single cottage at 2027 Cleveland Avenue for \$2,-500.

Charles Roth sold a double cottage at 1821-25 Collseum treet for \$2850; a lot in Melpomena, between Camp and Prvtania, for \$900 and a double two-story house at 1417-19 Melpomene street for \$1550.

Besides the university square, C. A. Tessier & Son sold seven building lots on Mobile street, corner of Adams, for \$5750.
